Jonathan Waters, the ancestor of the family of Waters in Hopewell, was one of the pioneers of this region, and was born in 1696.

In 1746, when the "Borough of Trenton" was chartered, and comprised within its limits all the territory then included in the townships of Hopewell and Maidenhead (now Lawrence), Jonathan Waters was one of the sixteen members of the common council, Jonathan Stout being the other member from northern Hopewell. This charter was surrendered in 1750 and Trenton again became a part of Hopewell township.

Jonathan Waters died in 1762, his will being probated September 27 of that year.

This will is very short and I will copy it in full, retaining capitalization and spelling as in the original copy, which is in the possession of John M. Titus, Esq., of Pennington, N. J., whose great great grandfather, Andrew Muirheid, was a son-in-law of Jonathan Waters, and one of the executors of the will, which is as follows:

"In the name of God Amen. I Jonathan Waters of the Township of Hopewell and County of Hunterdon, and State of New Jersey, being of sound mind, and calling to mind the certainty of death, and that the time thereof is uncertain, Do make and Ordain this my Last Will and

Testament in manner & form following, viz : Whereas principally and first of all, I recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the Earth to be Buried in a christian and Decent manner at the direction of my executors hereinafter mentioned, And as Touching such personal Estate as God hath made me steward of, after my just debts are paid, and all my funeral charges are paid, I give and bequeath, comit, Dispose and order, the same as hereafter followeth. I give all my movables to my son William Waters, and to my daughter Elizabeth, to be equally divided between them two.

Lastly, I constitute, make ordain and appoint my son William Waters and Andrew Muirheid to be my executors of this my Last Will and Testament.

In Witness Whereof, I have to this my Last Will and Testament set my hand and seal the second day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty. Signed, JONATHAN Waters.

Sealed, Signed and published as my last Will and Testament.
In presence of Albert Akers, John Davison, Stephen Jones."

In the name of God Amen, I William Waters Senior, of Shamokin township, Northumberland County, and State of Pennsylvania continuing(?) the uncertainty of this mortal life, and being in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory, Do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following .

First, it is my Will, that my body may be buried in a decent and christian like manner. And I do order that all my just debts, and burial expenses be paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently can be after my decease.

Second, I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Catharine so much of my household and kitchen furniture as she may stands in need of, to continue housekeeping, during her widowhood; also two cows the choice of two hogs, and two sheep. Further I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Catharine, as Long as she remains my widow, the mansion place on which I now reside adjoining lands of William Martz, William Farrow and others containing eighty acres by the same manner as to have the sole management of the same, and to receive the whole income of the same. Also the use of all the buildings thereon situated, in consideration of which my said wife shall provide for and maintain my two youngest daughters, Rebecca and Harriett Waters. Also to provide for their proper education and to provide a home for my two sons John and Charles R. Waters.

Third, One year after my said wife's decease, it is my Will and I do order, that my said mansion place shall be sold and the proceeds then equally divided among all my children except my sons John and Charles, to wit my son Godfrey to receive an equal share thereof. The heirs of my son Jonathan R. Waters deceased, viz, Charles, Henry Spencer, Wm. Dewart, Catharine and Jonathan, the said five heirs together to receive one equal share; my son John to receive \$150.00 over and above an equal share, my son William to receive one equal share with Godfrey; my son Charles R. to receive \$100.00 over and above an equal share, my daughter Elizabeth intermarried with Edward Wilkinson one equal share, my daughter Maria intermarried with Isaac Moore, one equal share to my daughter Nancy intermarried with Martin Leidy one equal share and to my daughter Rebecca, one equal share, and to my

daughter Harriett Waters one equal share. To be paid equally to each of the above mentioned, them or their legal representative, according to their respective proportion, whenever a payment is made.

Fourth, It is my Will and I do order that my said two youngest daughters Rebecca and Harriett, upon arriving at their respective ages shall receive as full, complete and decent an outset(?) as their older sisters received when leaving home.

Fifth, It is further my wish that all my personal estate, which my said wife may not need for housekeeping, shall be sold and appropriated for the payment of my just debts. But in case my personal estate should prove insufficient for the payment of my debts in such case my hereafter named Executors, I do hereby empower and authorize to sell sufficient of my estate for the payment of said debts, but they shall only sell such part thereof, that shall not materially injure the farm.

Sixth, It is further my Will and I do order that after my said wife deceases, the remaining personal estate shall be equally divided among all my above mentioned children or their legal representatives. Share and share alike.

Seventh, It is also my wish, and I do hereby order, that in case my said wife should die before my youngest daughters may age, my son Charles R. Frank Joseph Waters grew up to become a newspaperman, an amateur but respected anthropologist, and an accomplished and quite well known writer of fiction and non-fiction.

Frank Waters is frequently described as a "western" writer, that is, as a regional writer, but in fact his themes are too broad to really be categorized that way. His settings and characters are almost alWays of the west, but the big overriding theme of the works, both in fiction and non-fiction, is the struggle (not alWays succesful) to reconcile contraries or opposing modes of existence, expressed through clAshing systems of belief or individual temperaments or in racial or ethnic differences. Invariably, the critics and academics who have studied and written about Frank Waters' works have pointed to the source of this recurrent theme of opposition in Frank Water's own family background.

The work by Frank Waters that was probably the one most widely known during his lifetime was *Diamond Head*, mainly I think because a movie was made from it. However, the work for which he is best known among scholars and writers today is probably his trilogy titled *Pikes Peak, A Mining Saga*, which is a reissue of three of his very early novels: *The Wild Earth's Nobility*, *Below Grass Roots*, and *The Dust Within the Rock*. This trilogy is in fact an only slightly fictionalized story of his family, focusing mainly on his maternal grandfather Joseph Dozier, but also on the larger family. Because I've done a lot of research on Frank Water's family, above all on the DeVinneys to whom I am related, on the Doziers and now on the Waters, I have been able to distinguish (more or less) the facts and the fiction. Much of what he writes about is true, and almost all the characters existed (although in reality there were several more members of the family present). He does change some names (Dozier for instance becomes Rogier), although others he keeps as they were (the DeVinneys, e.g., with some changes in first names and kinship). Spencer Waters' son Frank Jonathan Waters is a major character later in the work, and though his name is changed to Jonathan Cable, he is pretty much portrayed as he was, the father of Frank J. (who calls himself March Cable).
